- 3. Applicant must have a cumulative high school/college/technical school grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

- 2. Letter of acceptance from the school you are or will be attending.
- 3. Verification of a 2.5 GPA or above.

Only those applicants that fully complete the entire application and submit all requested documents will be considered.
